

THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH
(BRIDGE STREET, PETERBOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF CYCLING) ORDER 1995

The Council of the City of Peterborough (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council Of Cambridgeshire in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1)(a), 2(1), and 2(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the City of Peterborough (Bridge Street, Peterborough) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 1st. December 1995.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall ride or cause to be ridden any pedal bicycle or tricycle in either direction along the entire length of that section of Bridge Street between its junctions with Bourges Boulevard and Cathedral Square between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays (Inclusive)
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any pedestrian from pushing a bicycle or tricycle in the length of road specified in that Article
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
