#### Amended Motion from Councillor Holdich

This Council notes the announcement by the Chancellor of a devolution deal for the East in his budget on 16<sup>th</sup> March. But, regrets that the deal, in its current form, ~~is not acceptable to this Council~~ appears not to be acceptable to this Council.

This Council resolves to:

- (i) Set up a Cross Party Working Group of Council to robustly examine the contents of the proposal from Government as well as receiving the results of the engagement/consultation with stakeholders, and the public, with a view to assisting this Council when it meets in June 2016 to determine whether to continue with the statutory consultation.
- ii) In parallel to (i) above, work with Cambridgeshire County Council and Cambridge City Council in support of its discussions with Government concerning the desire for a devolution deal to be based on a Peterborough and Cambridgeshire geography and, in particular, advocate for opportunities to join with other Council's surrounding Peterborough who represent a key part of Peterborough's economic geography.
- iii) request that the Chief Executive write to the Secretary of State for Local Government to bring this resolution to his attention.
